- Apply energy efficiency and CO₂ reduction strategies
- Evaluate organizational structures of airports and airlines
- Identify legal and policy frameworks in aviation
- Engage in proactive and critical discussions on corporate governance in the air transport sector

CONTENU ET STRUCTURE

The program covers sustainability in airports and airlines, aviation law, aeronautical industry management, and air navigation. It includes practical case studies, executive-level lectures, and concludes with a graduation ceremony at the United Nations in Geneva.

MÉTHODOLOGIE

Fully e-learning, based on asynchronous modules, proactive discussion forums, and real-world case study analyses. Includes mentoring from top-level industry professionals and interactive learning components.
