### BACKGROUND

The CO-OP Responsibility Program is a collaborative educational initiative developed by BAU CO-OP in partnership with Darüşşafaka, CIFAL Istanbul, UNITAR, and Bahçeşehir University. Running from September 18, 2024, to May 15, 2025, the program aims to raise awareness among high school and university

students about key global challenges such as sustainability and climate change. Through expert-led sessions, it supports the development of socially responsible, environmentally conscious individuals, in line with Sustainable Development Goal 4: Quality Education. The program emphasizes experiential learning and youth engagement as essential tools for driving long-term positive change.
